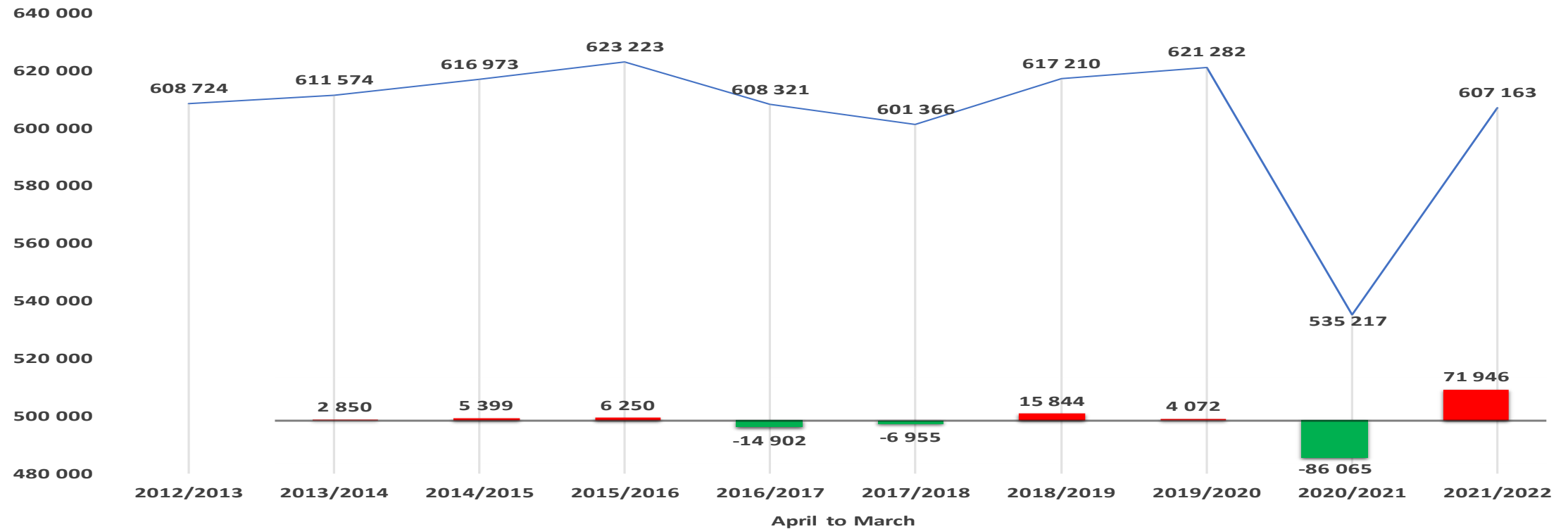

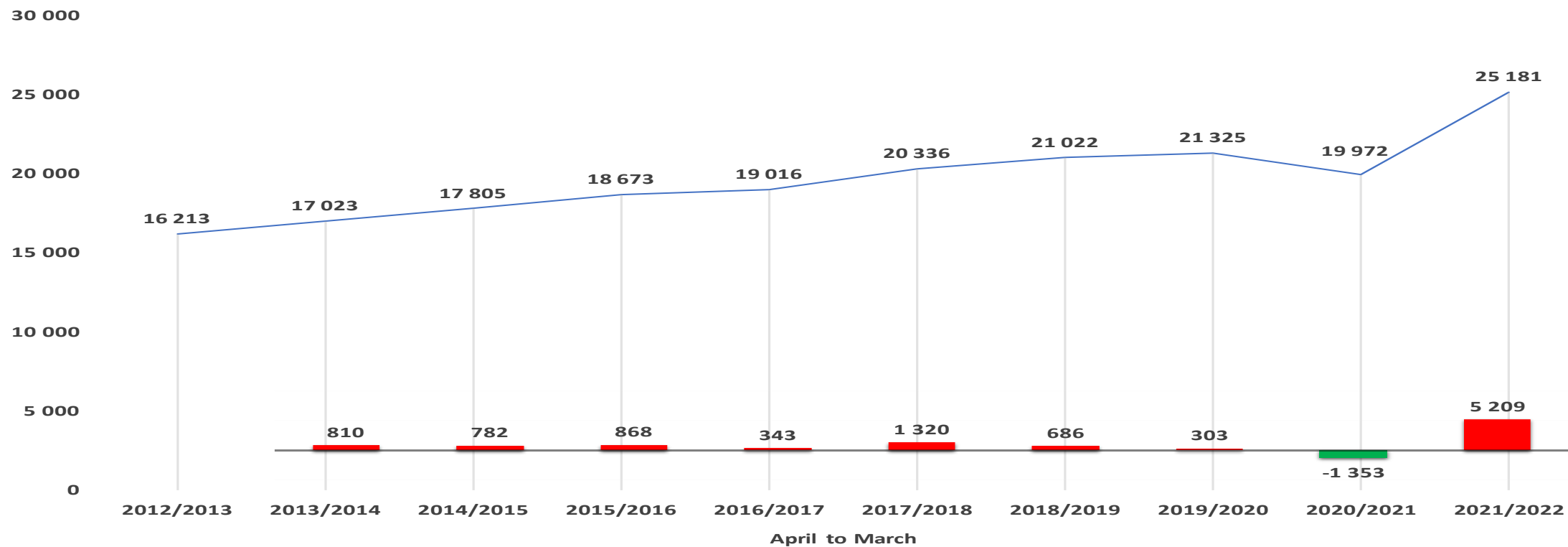

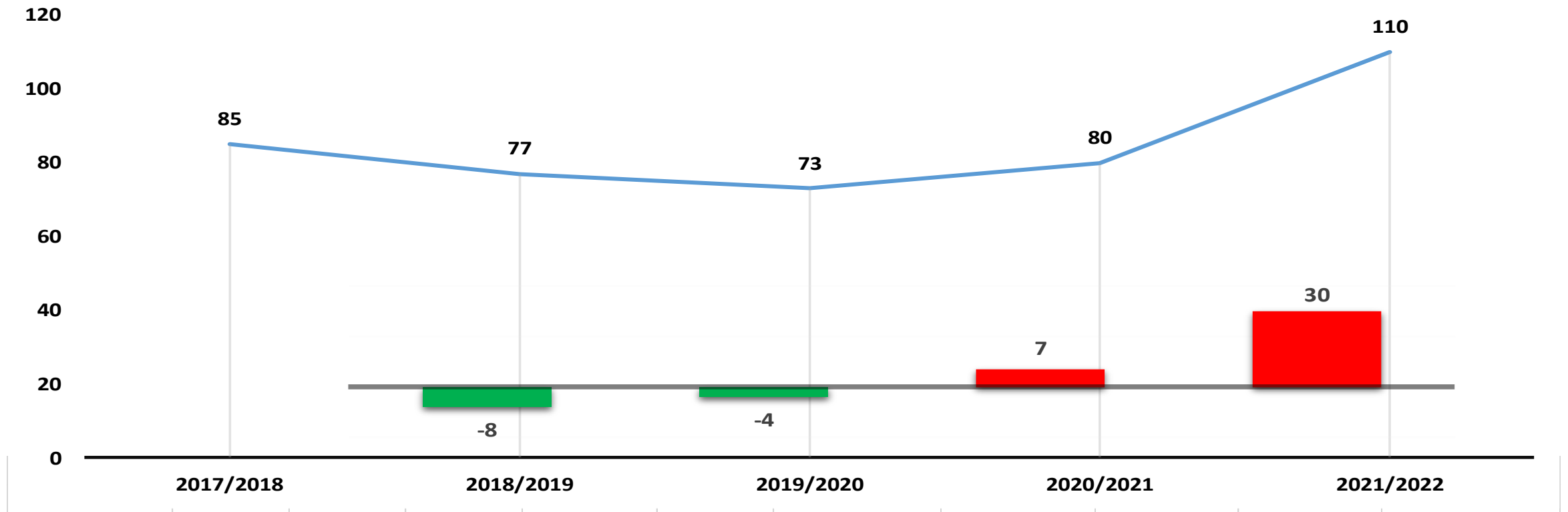

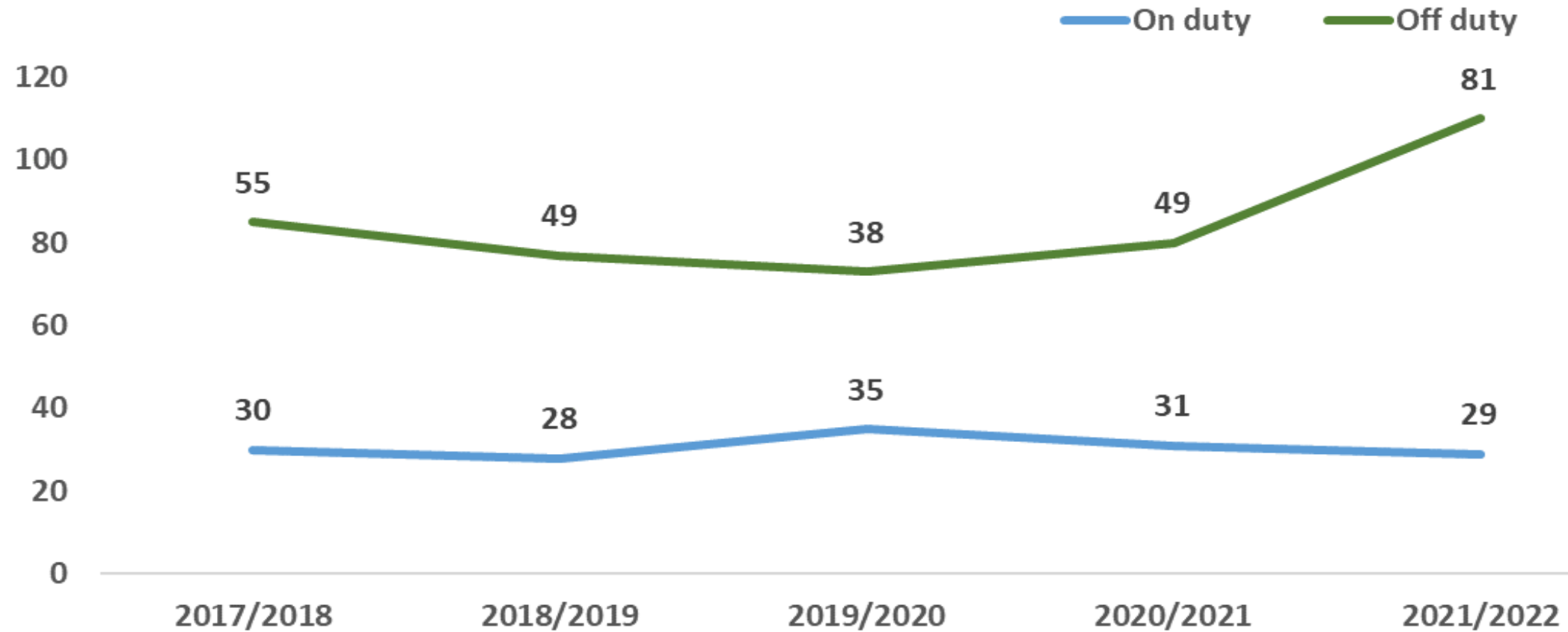

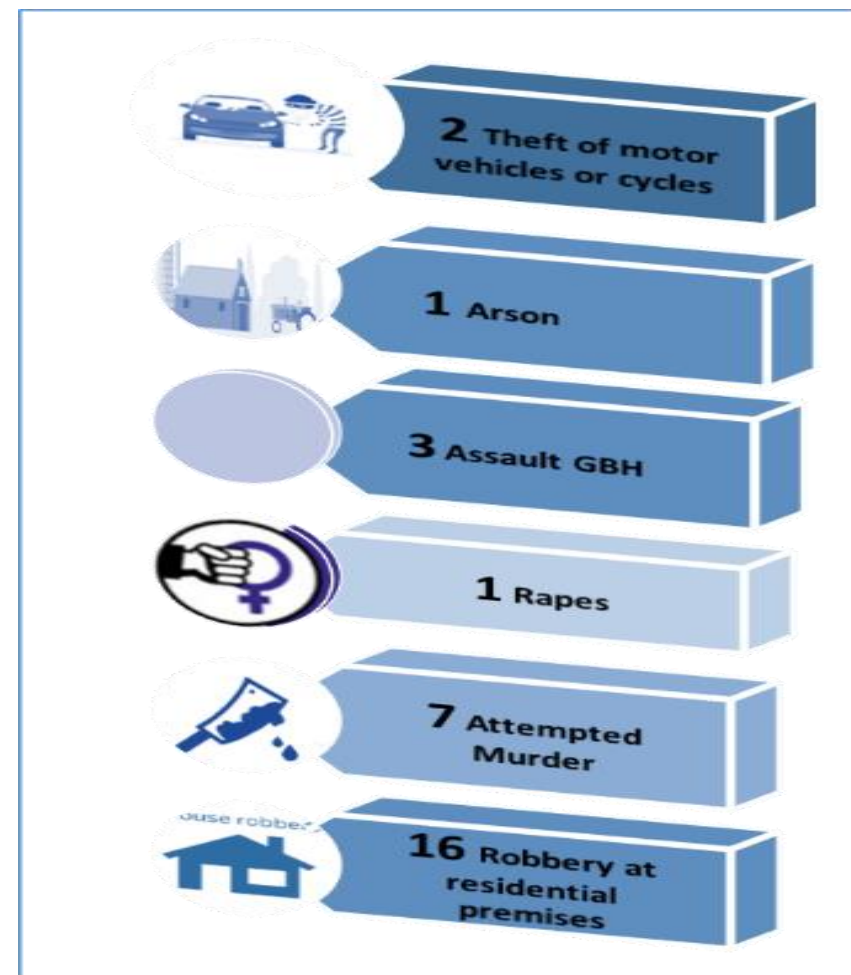
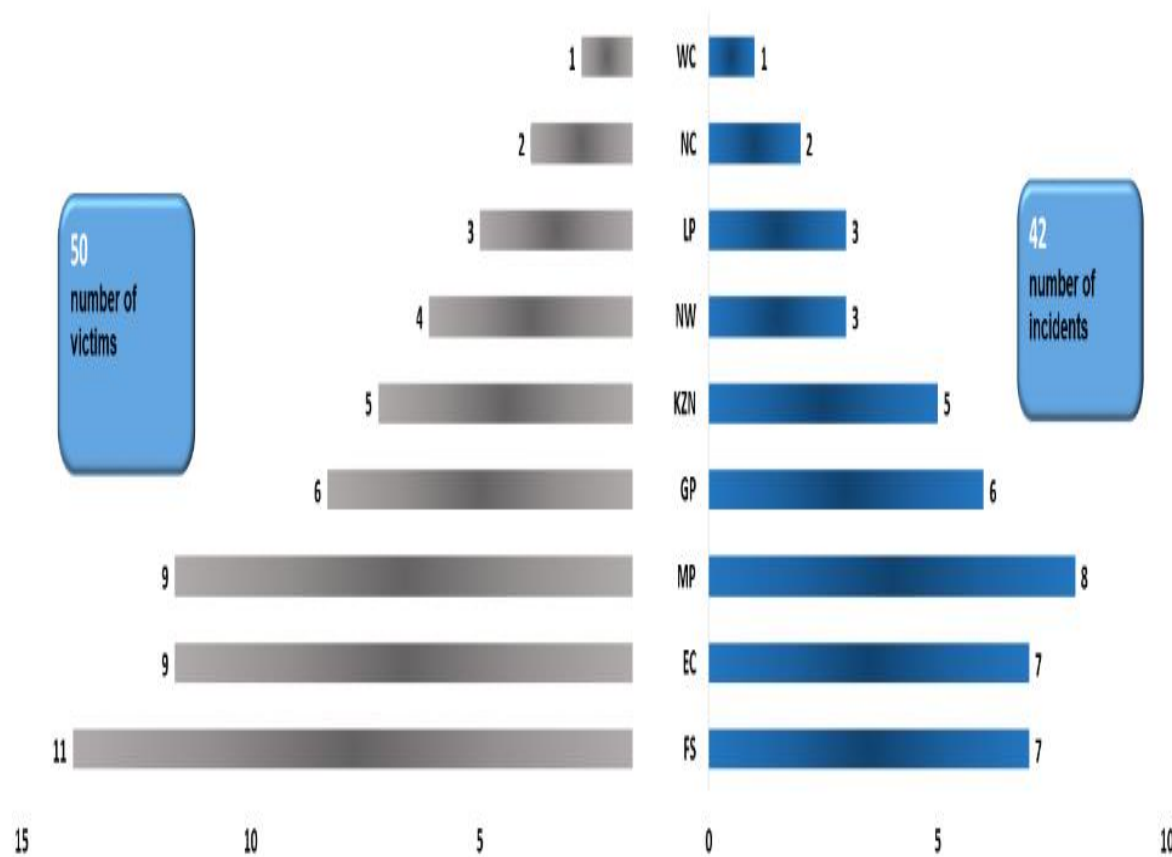


MURDER OF MEMBERS OF THE POLICE SERVICE: ON AND OFF-DUTY APRIL TO MARCH 2021/2022



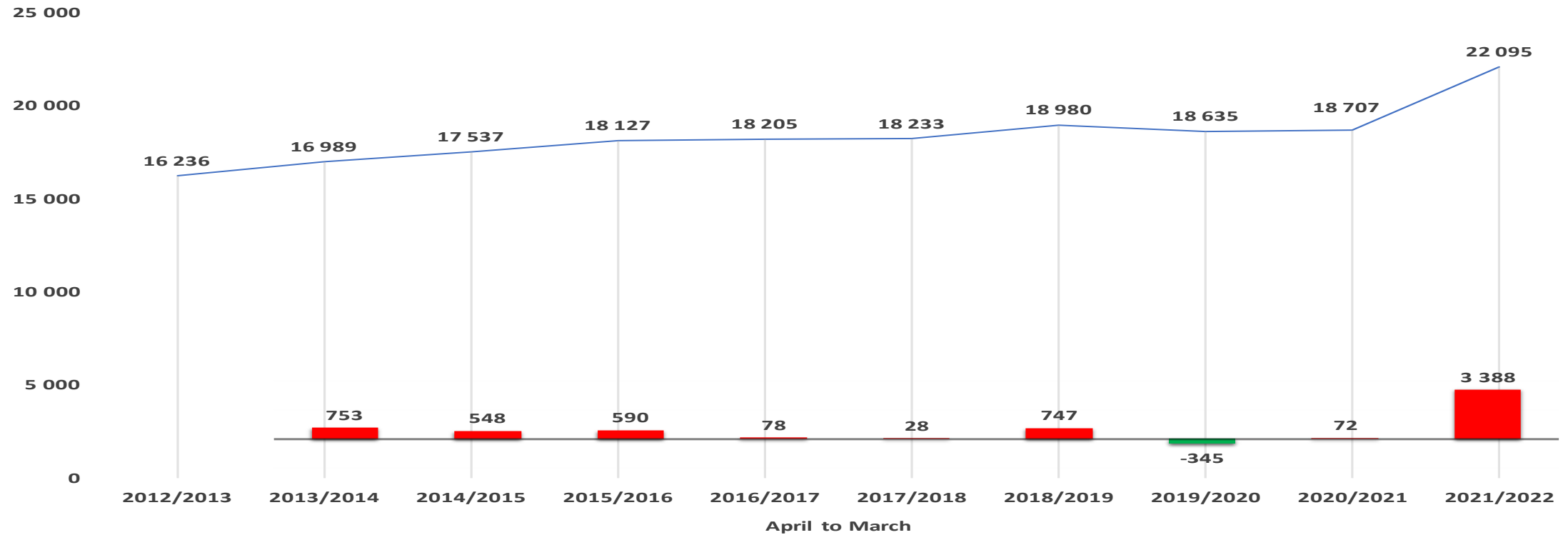

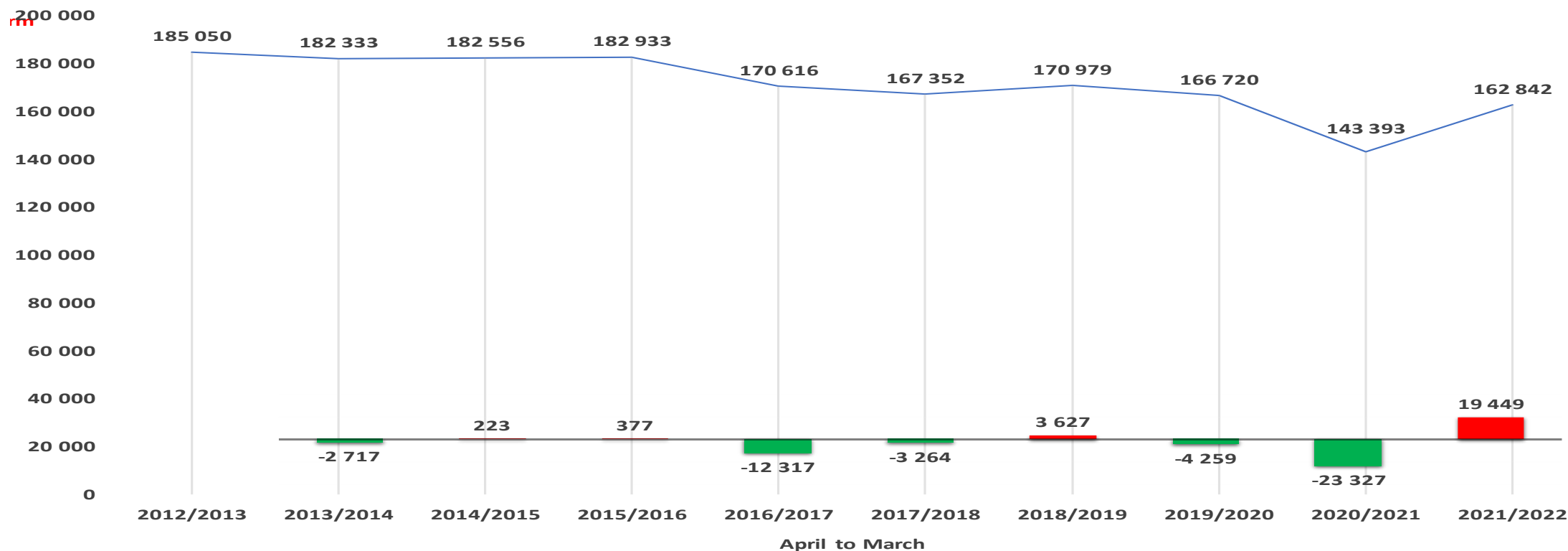


ATTEMPTED MURDER TOP 30 STATIONS

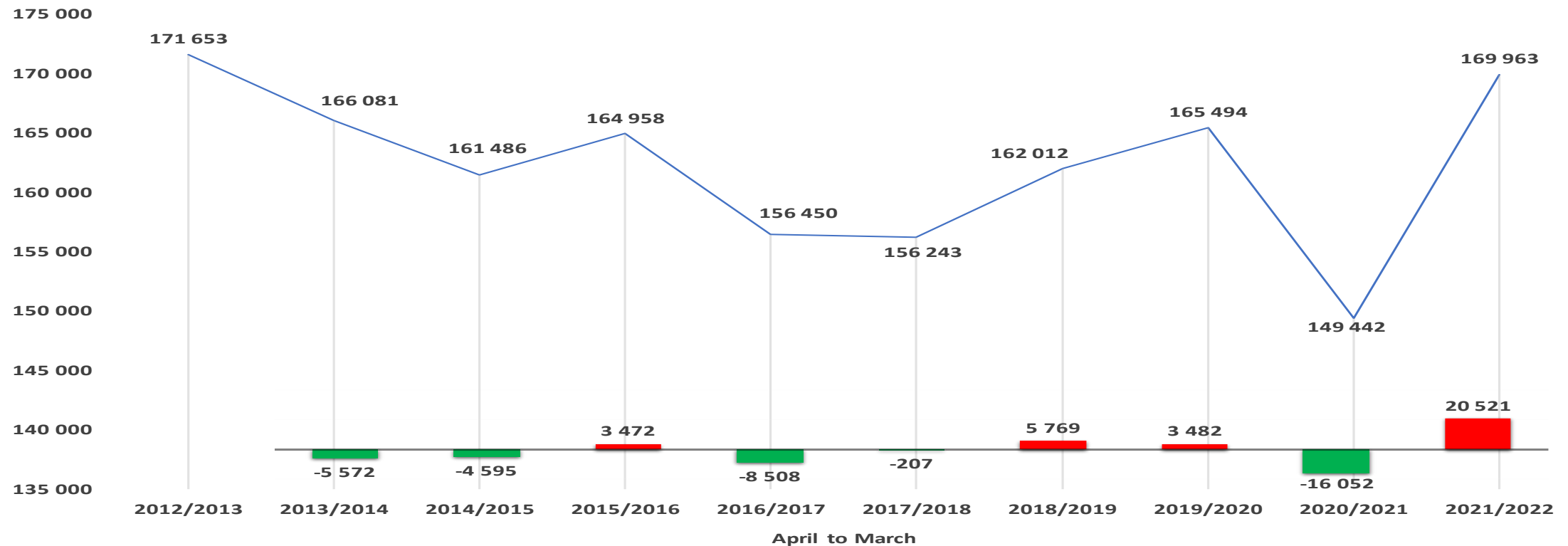

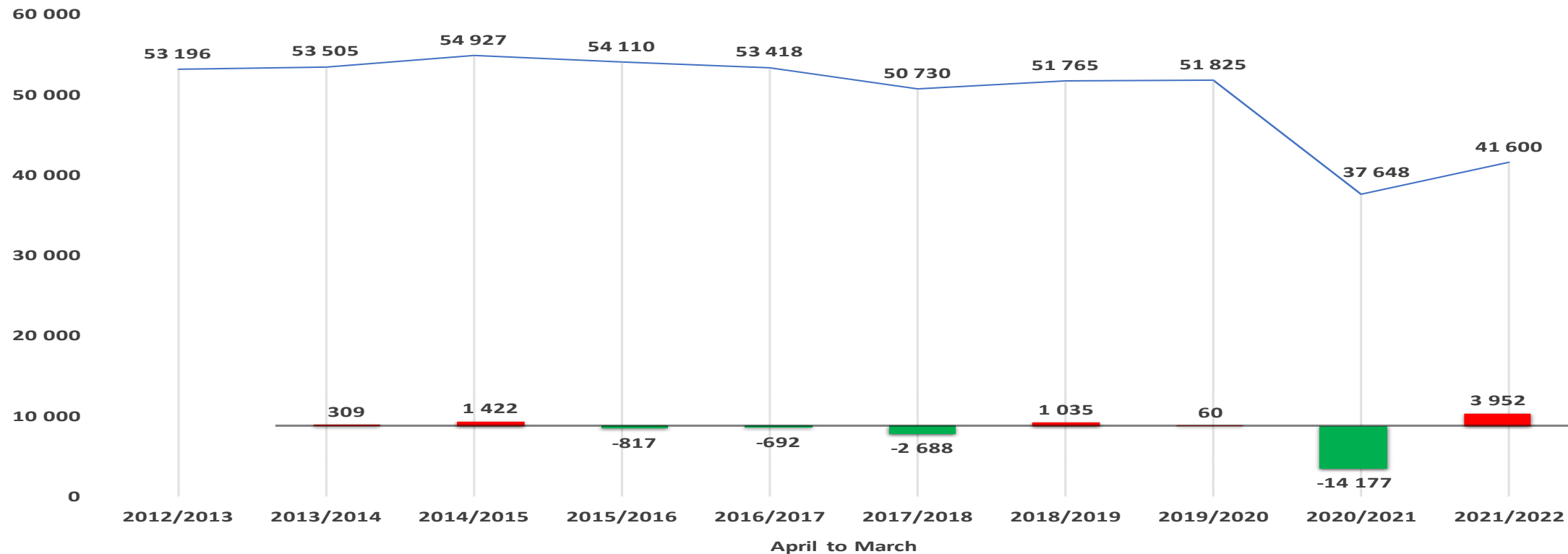

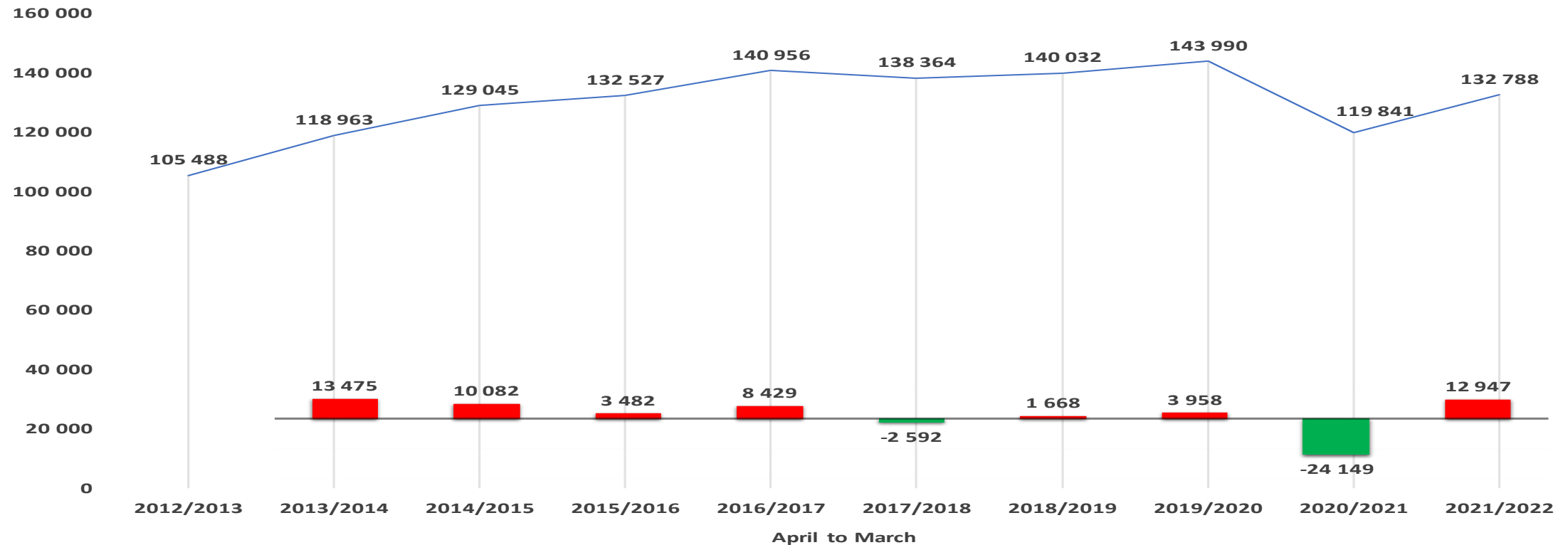

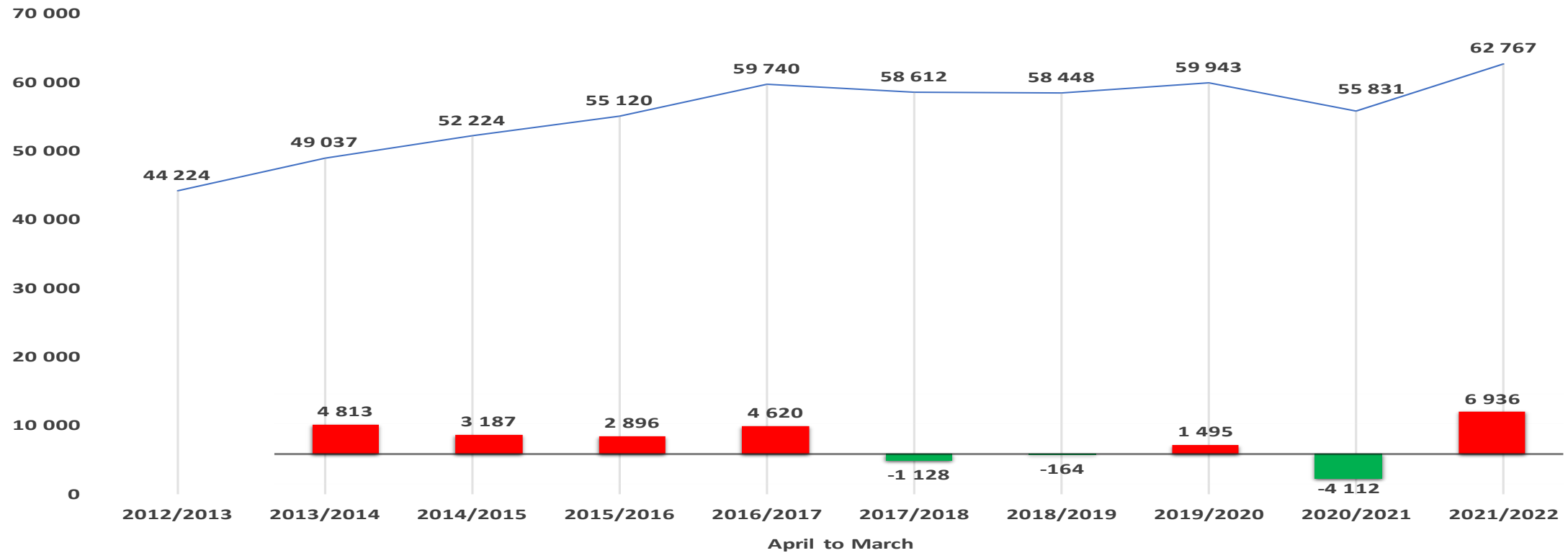

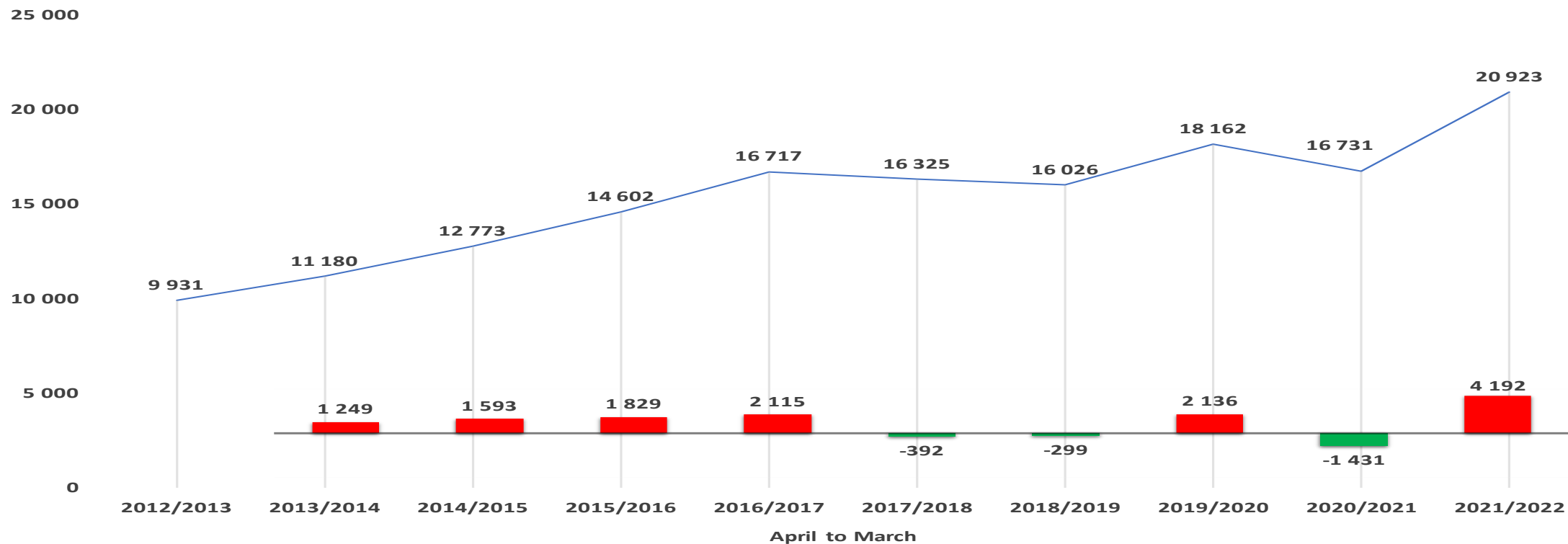

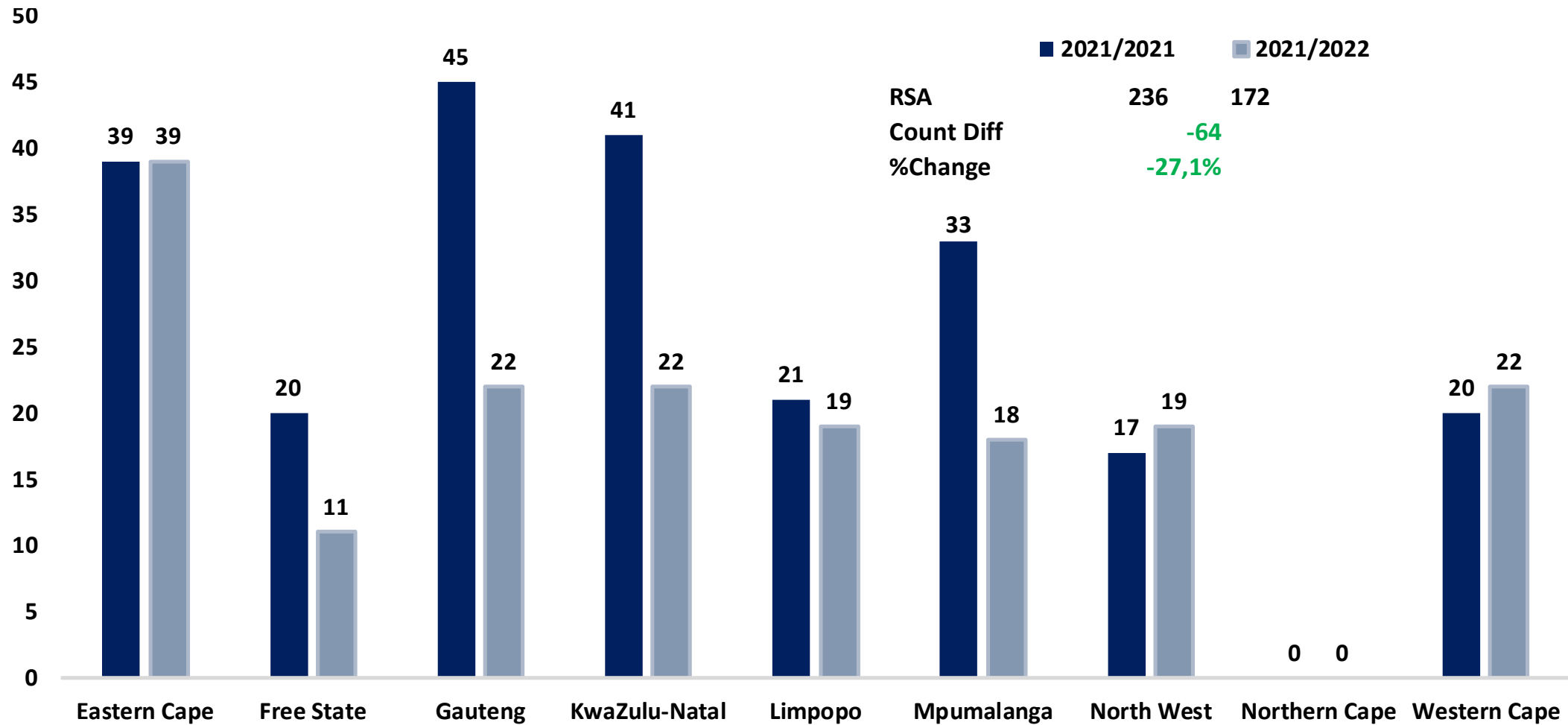

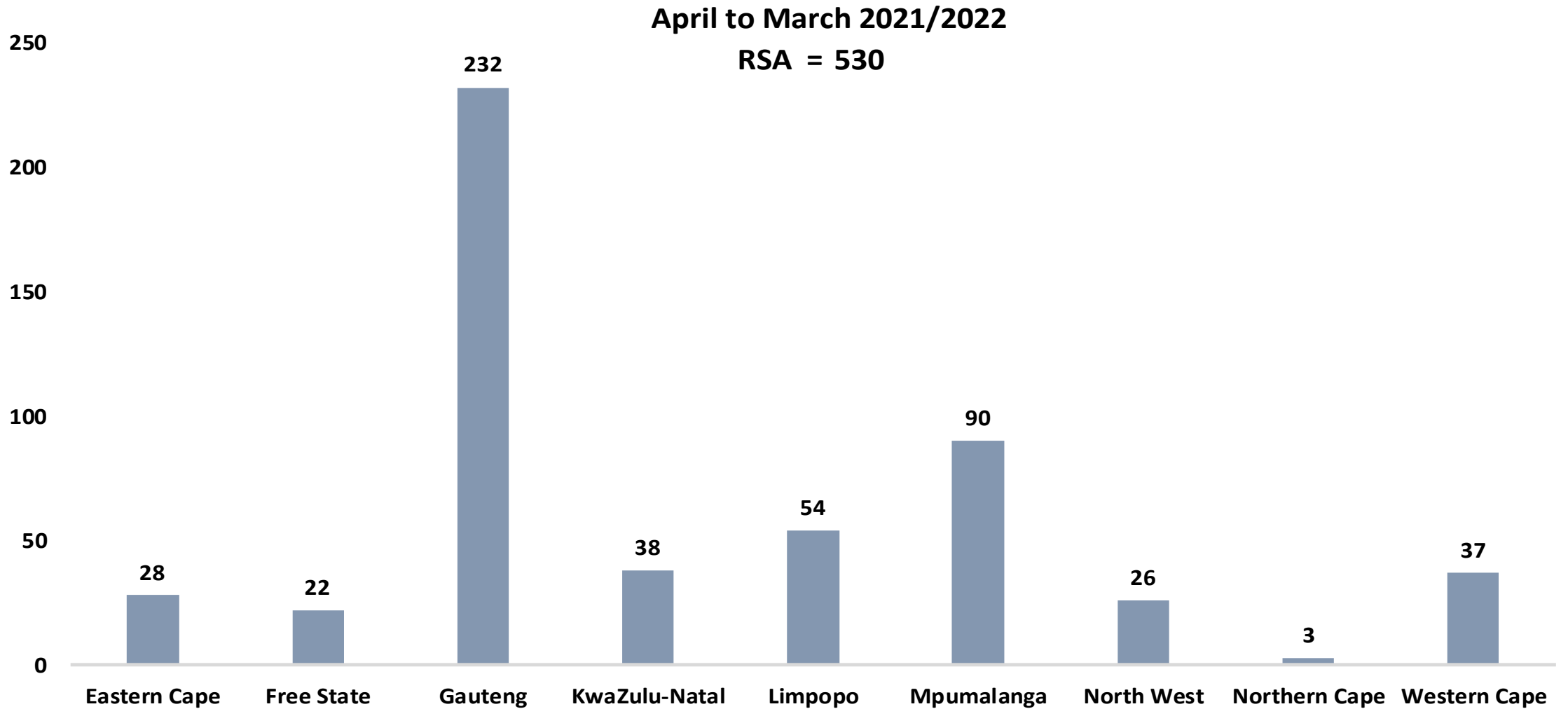

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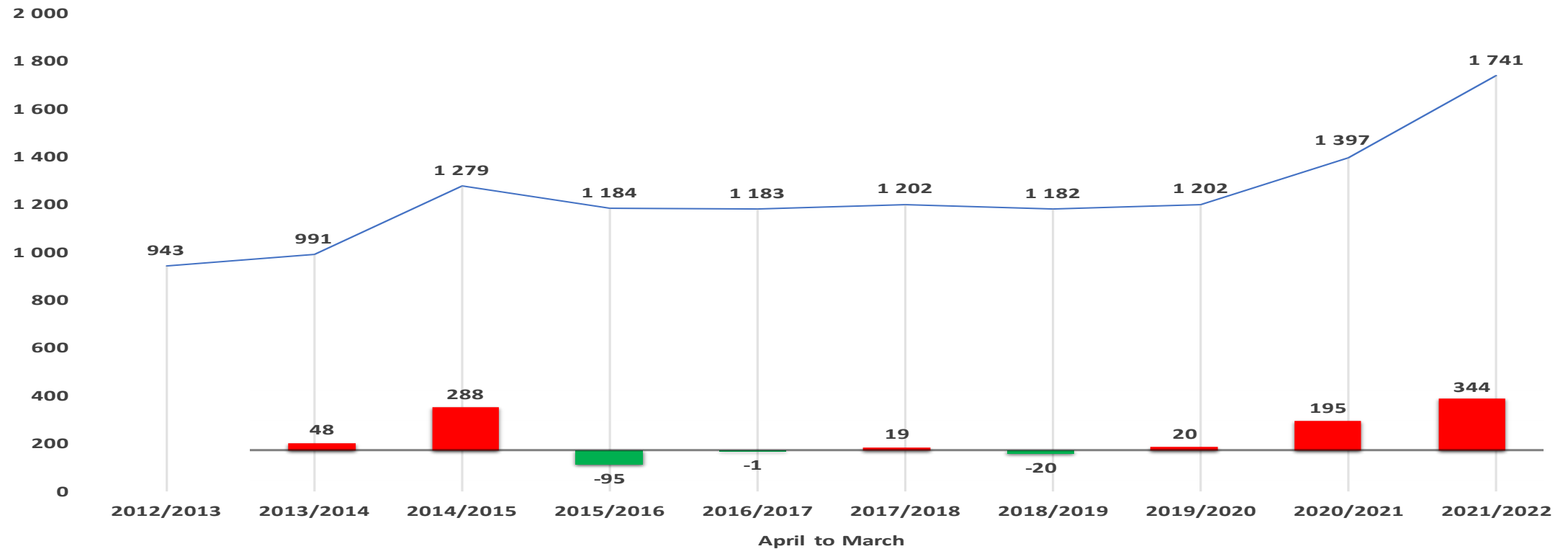

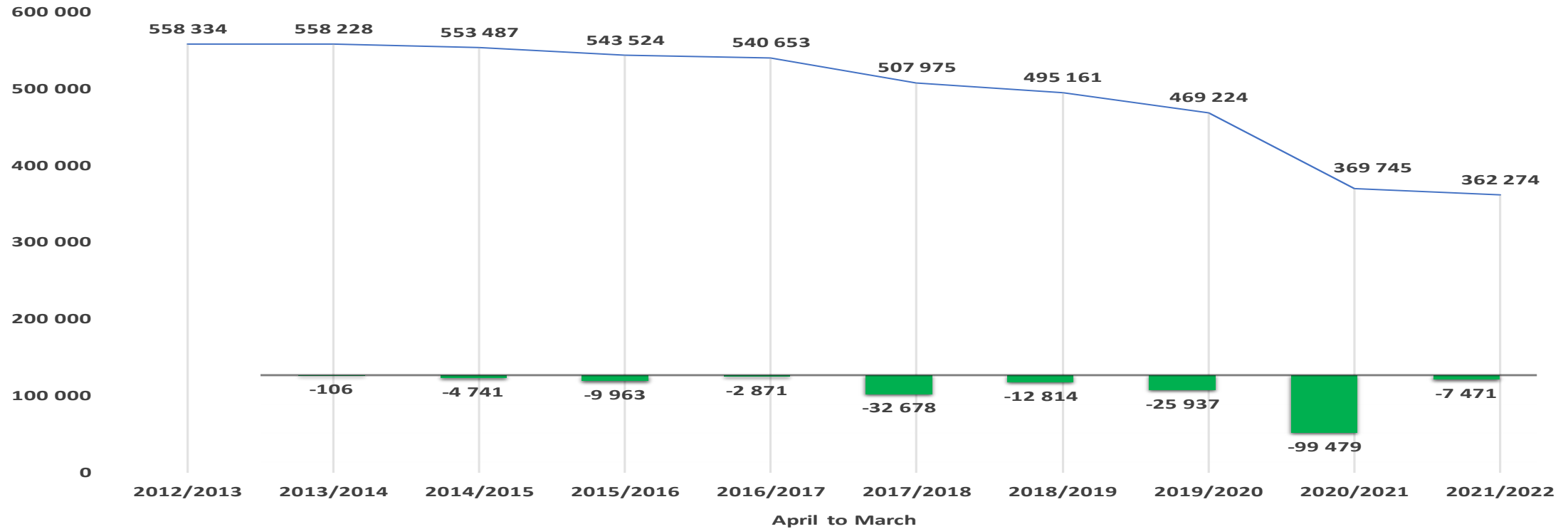

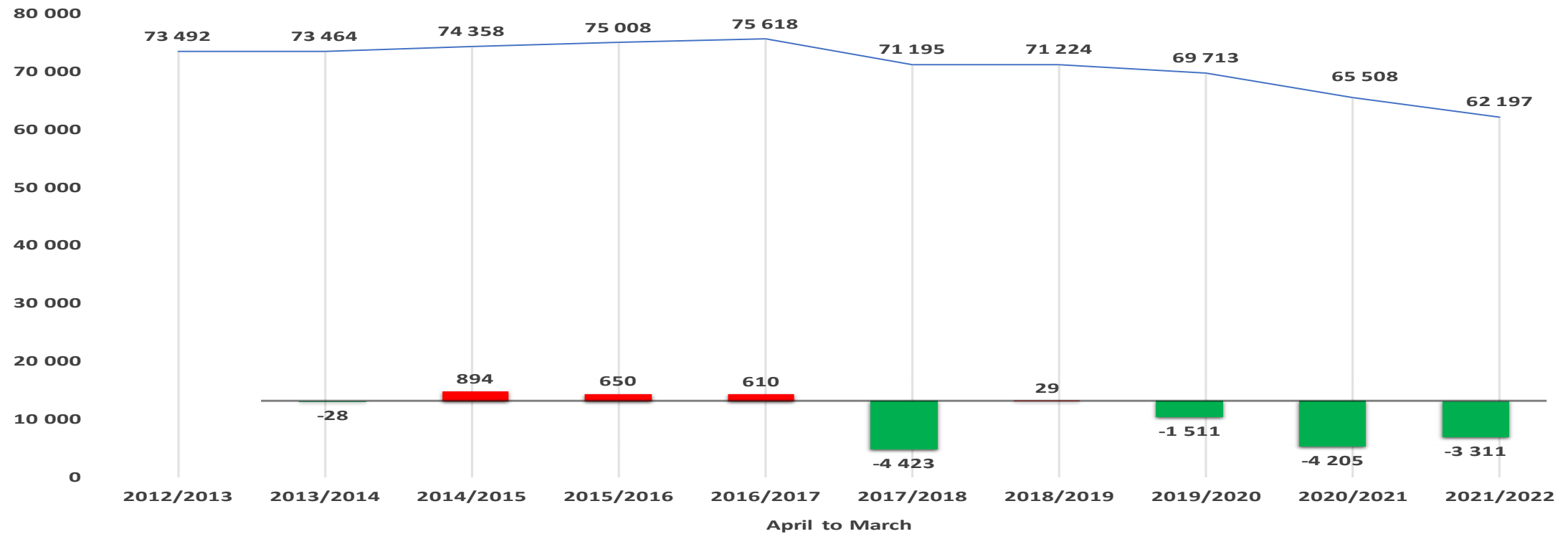

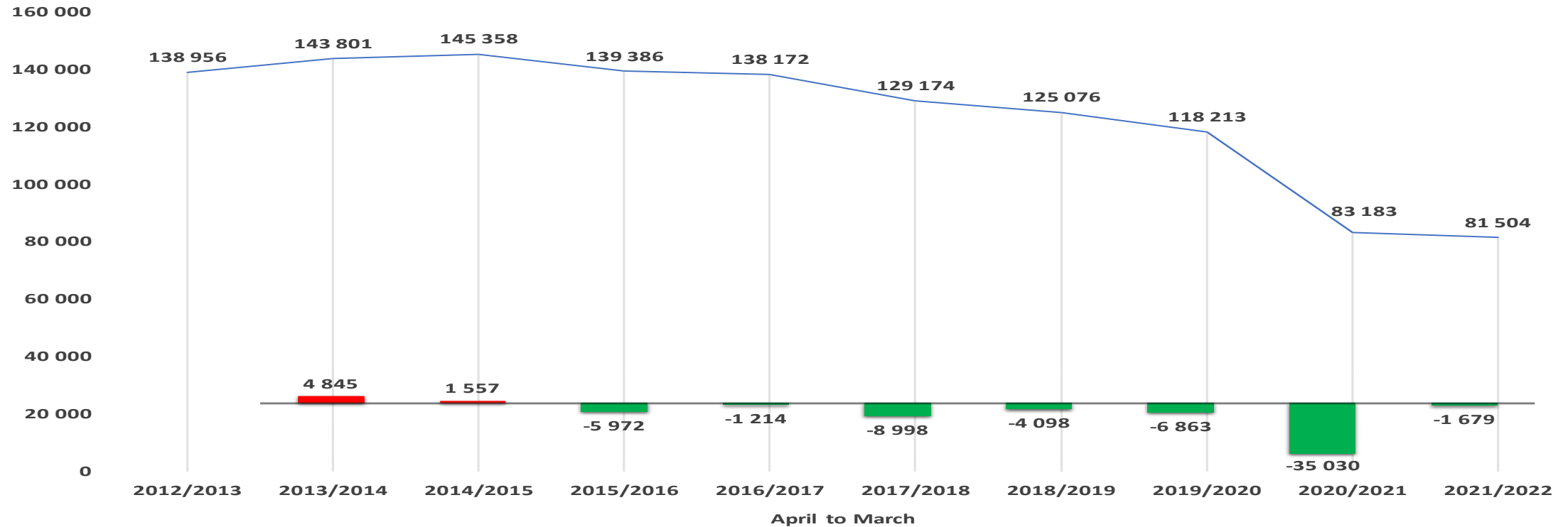

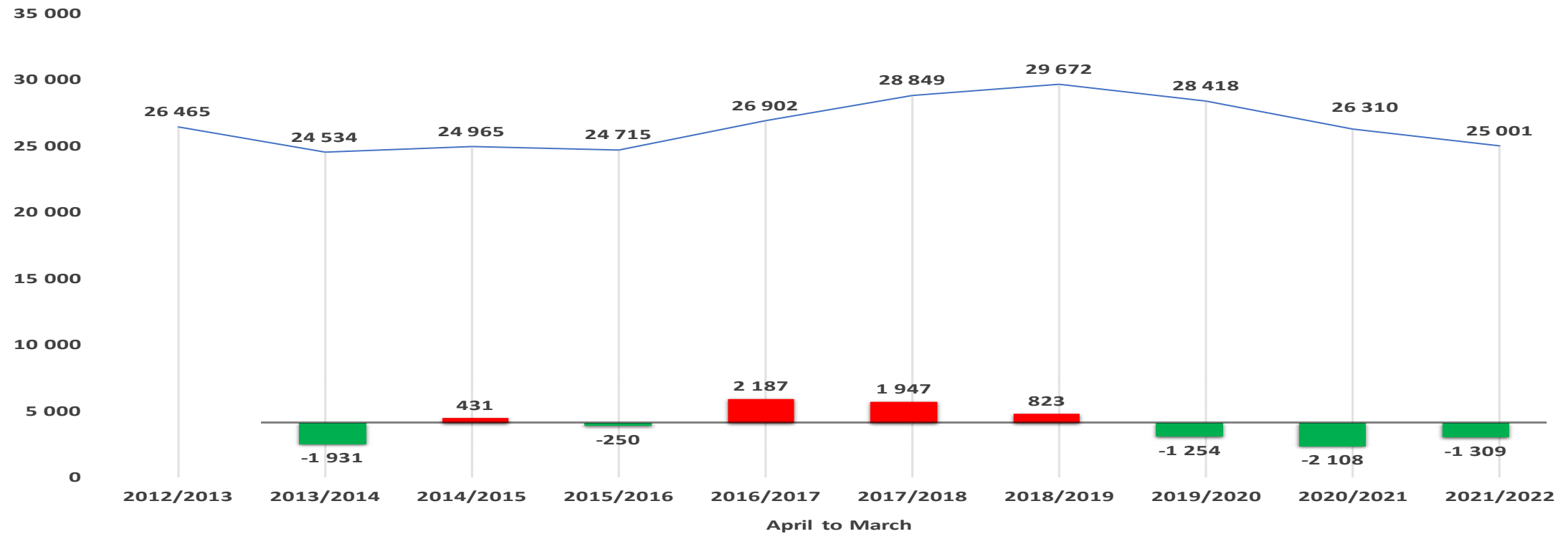

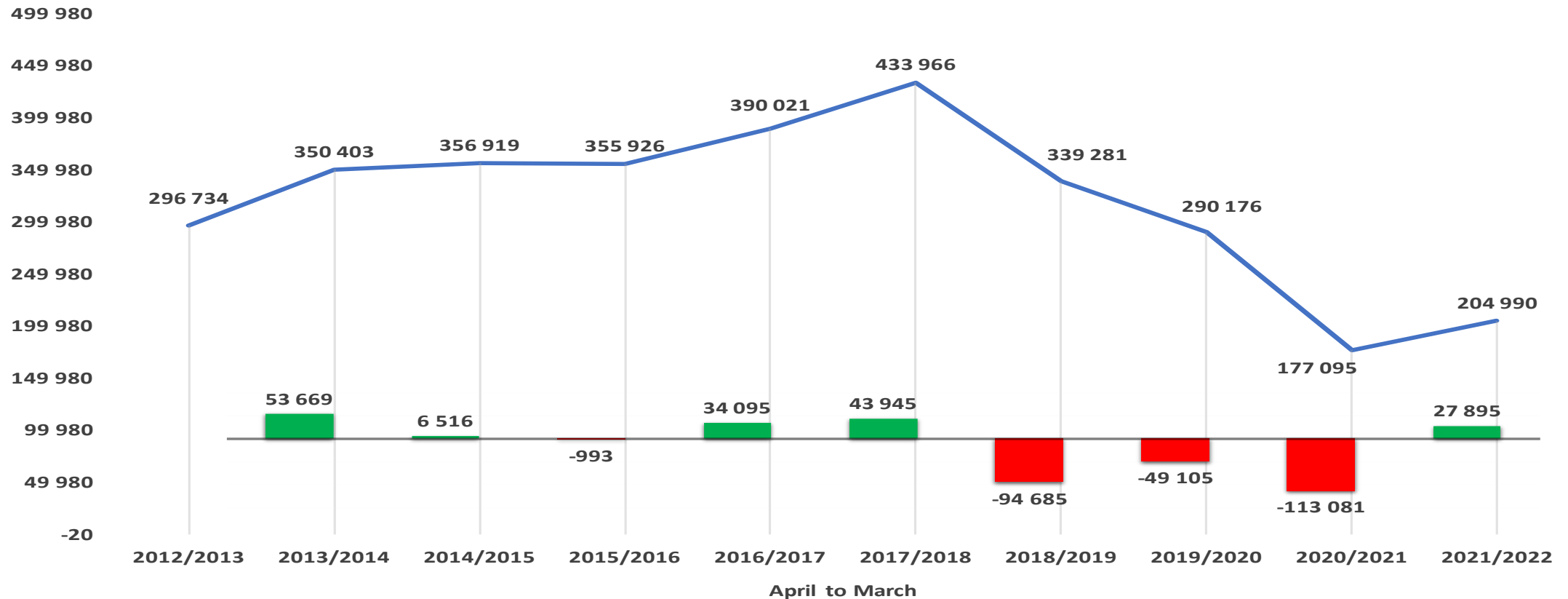
CRIME DETECTED AS A RESULT OF POLICE ACTION

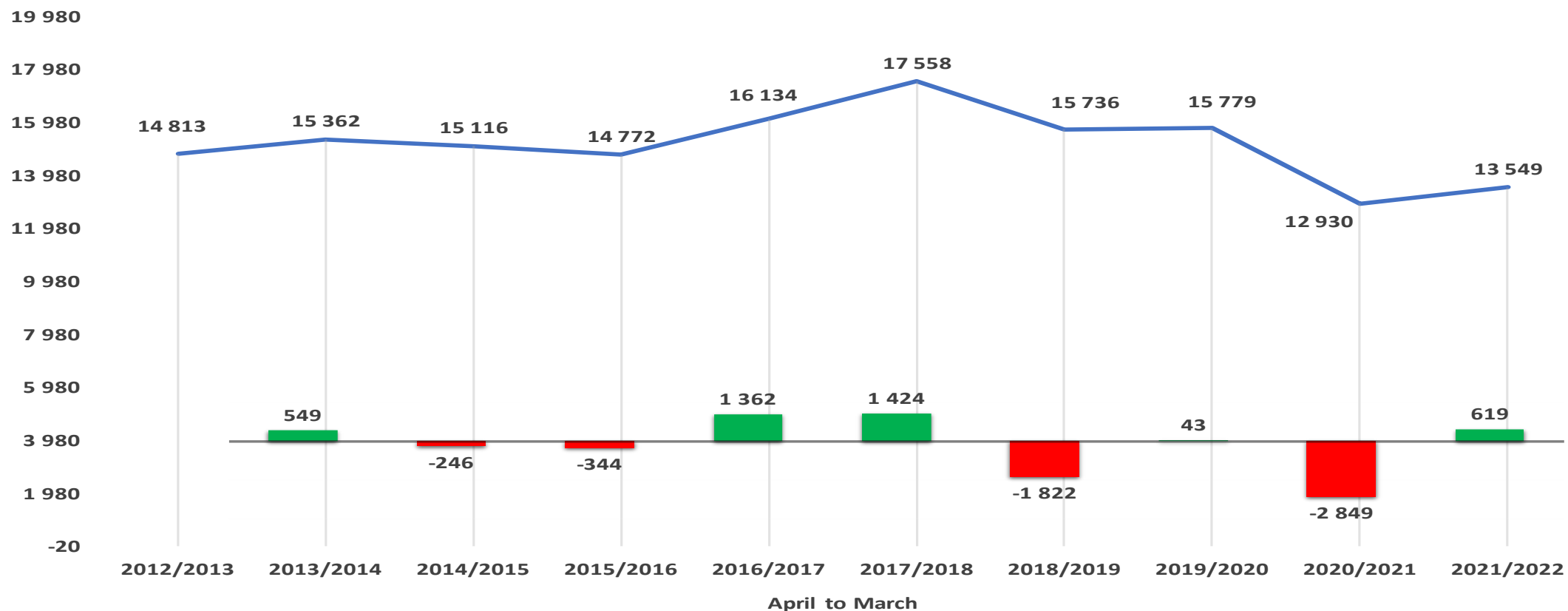

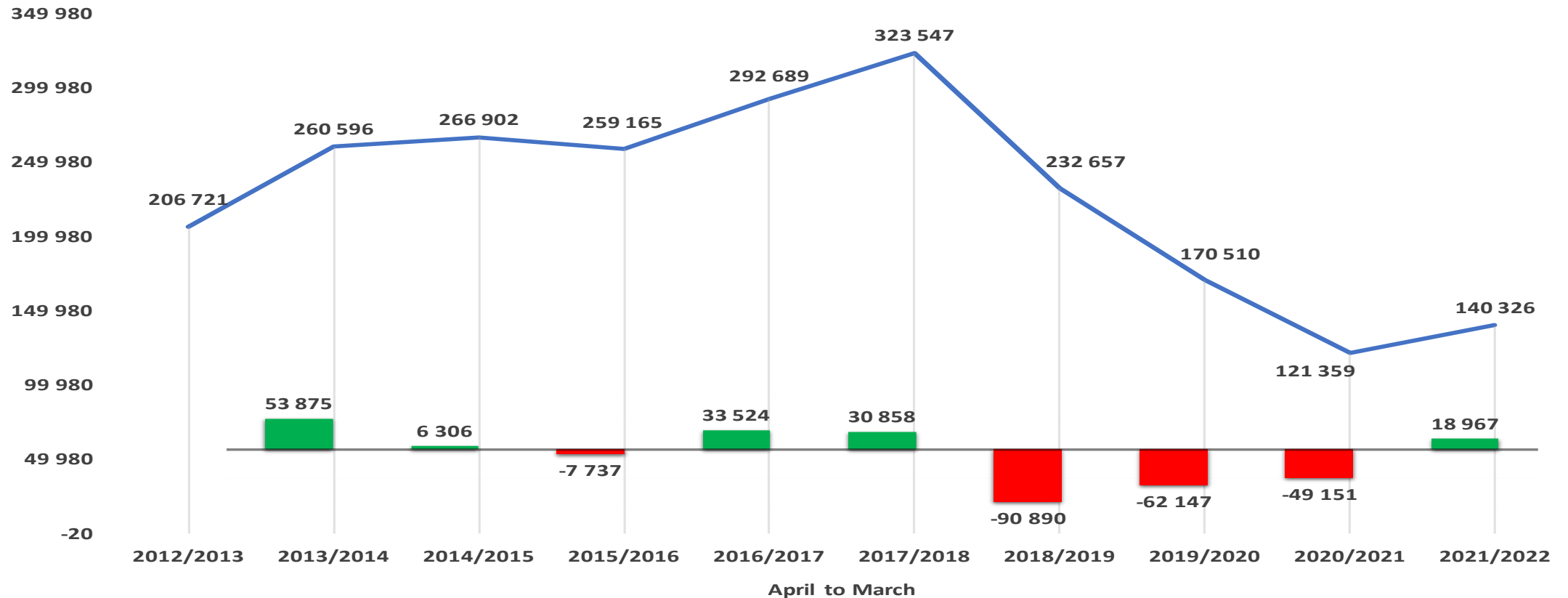

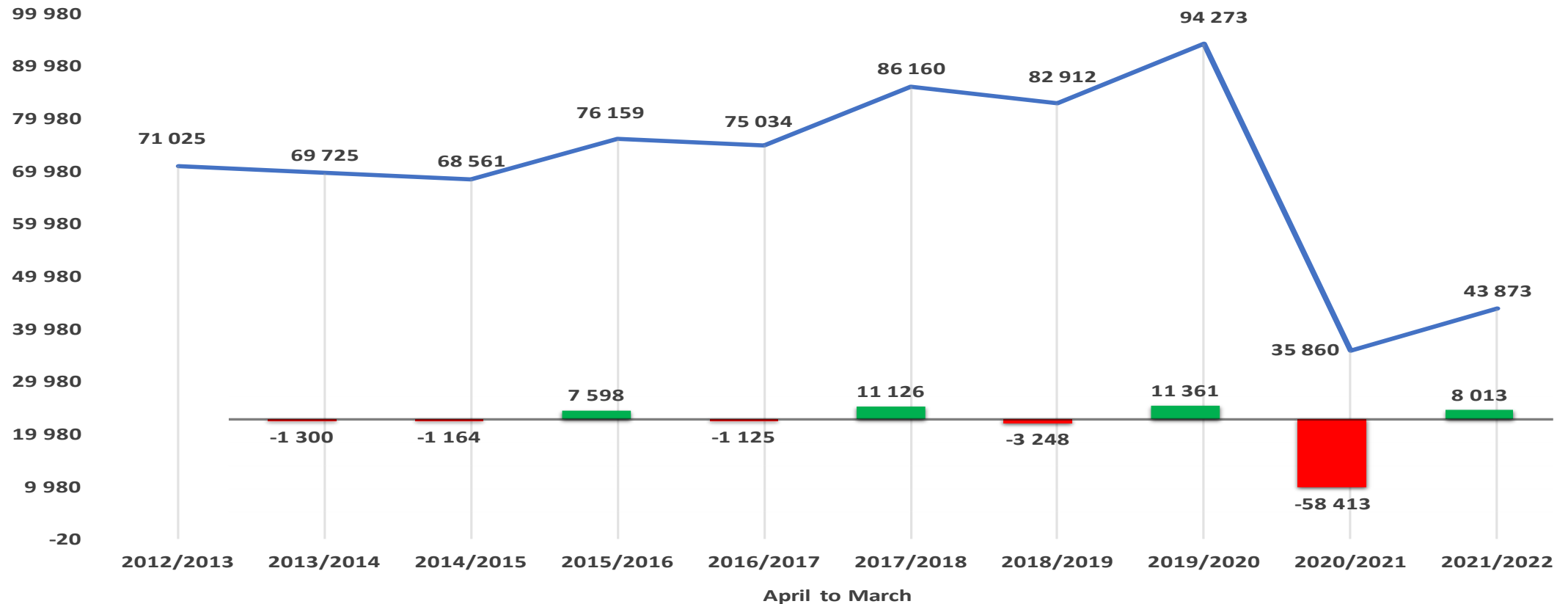

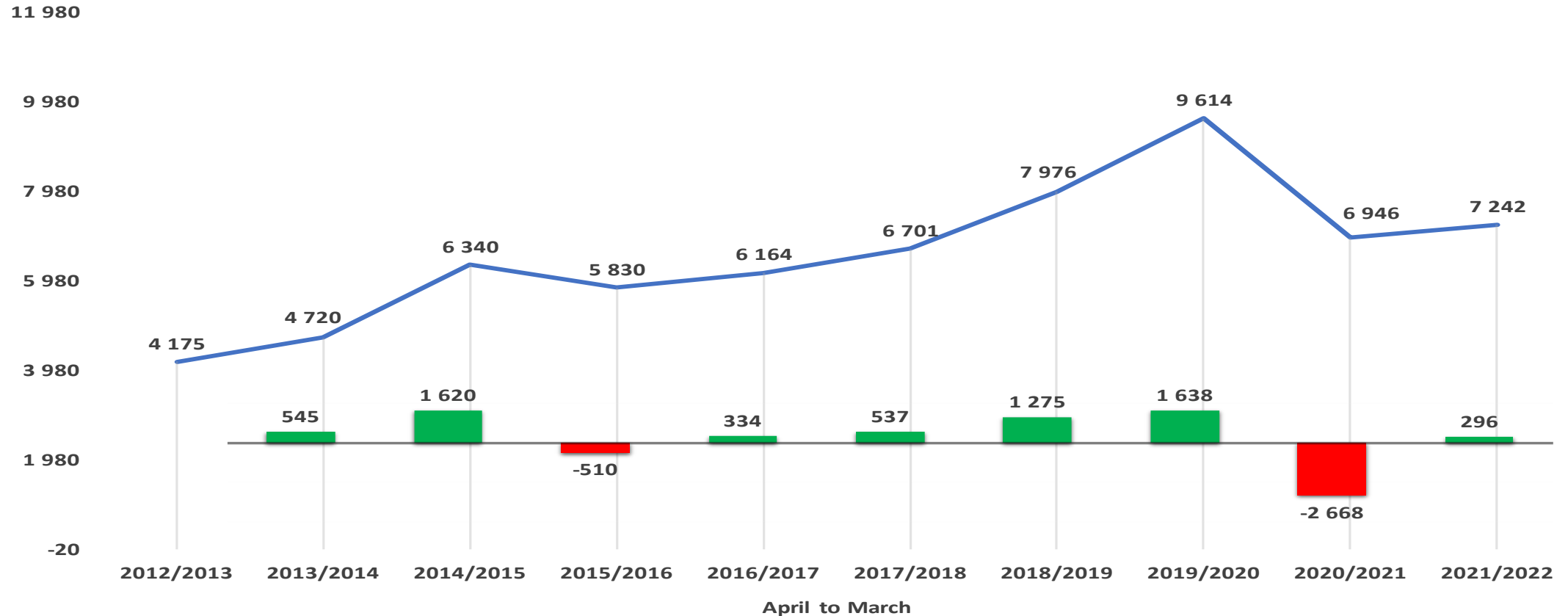

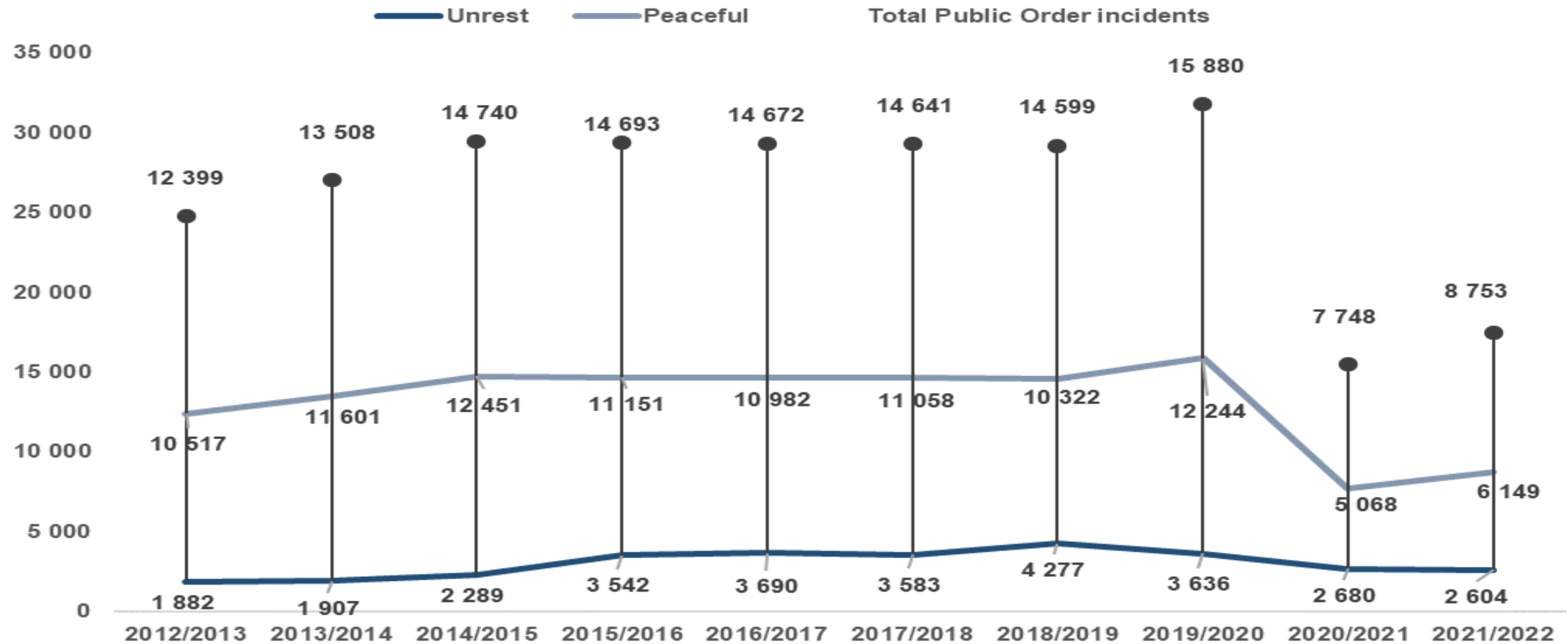
